Welcome! USA Competitions is proud to host the 2012 Presidential Classic. We are also very pleased to have been chosen for the 3rd year in a row as a Nastia Liukin Cup qualifying event for level 10/Open female athletes from the USA! Please review the following items enclosed in this packet:

Rosters will be emailed to each club. They will be posted online without birth dates (for athlete security). Coaches, please carefully check your team rosters for the correct spelling of your athlete's names, correct date of birth & missing USAG numbers. Parents, please check with your club coach for session assignments (also listed on the rosters).

Athlete & Coach Registration – All athletes and coaches must check in at the registration office set up at the ESPN Wide World of Sports Complex to submit your Disney Sports Waiver, receive credentials and athlete gifts prior to entering the competition venue. The Sports Waiver is attached—last page. **Each athlete must submit a waiver individually at registration to receive a Disney credential. Athlete waivers will not be accepted by a club coach at check in and may not be submitted in advance.** We must collect them at Disney this year. Be sure to keep your credentials with you throughout the weekend. They are your ticket to enter the complex. It is advisable that gymnasts (and coaches) arrive a minimum of 45 minutes prior to scheduled general stretch time, to allow ample time for the walk from the parking lot and for the registration process.

Coaches, be sure to bring your USAG card, as all information from it will be required on the USAG Coaches Sign In Sheet. All expiration dates are required to be recorded on the sign in sheet (expiration dates for membership, safety and background check). Coaches must initial the sanction sign in sheet inside the competition arena, at the main computer table. ***Emailing the names and USAG numbers of attending coaches to Sharyn@usacompetitions.com in advance will be very convenient for you, as memberships can be verified and recorded prior to the event!***

Coaches meeting — There will be a brief coaches meeting 5 minutes after the start of stretch before each session.

Cash Prizes for 1st-3rd place USAG team — **Optional prizes are 1st Place \$200 / 2nd Place \$150 / 3rd Place \$100. Compulsory team prizes are 1st Place \$100 / 2nd Place \$80 / 3rd Place \$50**

Cash prizes will be awarded 50% to coaches from the winning teams at the meet & 50% to gym or booster club via check. Coaches will claim winnings by signing the award ledger at the main computer scoring table. If prize money is not claimed at the meet, the full amount will be mailed to the club.

Awards Ceremonies— Award ceremonies take place following each session. 50% + 1 is awarded individually and also for team. 100% all around is awarded. All athletes are recognized for their efforts!

Hospitality—Snacks and coffee will be provided to the **coaches** in the hospitality area throughout the event. Disney gift cards for dining at your convenience will be distributed (*with a club coach signature & ID*), along with your packet at the main computer scoring table. Do not lose the gift card—it is like cash. It can be used at any restaurant or gift shop/store on Disney property (small snack kiosks may be the only exception. I do not believe they accept the card).

Gymnasts who compete in the Nastia Liukin Cup will receive a Nastia Liukin-designed leotard and a warm-up from GK Elite; two tickets to the AT&T American Cup and recognition during the event; and the opportunity to meet Liukin and participate in a team photo.

What is the difference between the Senior Division and the Junior Division?

An athlete that turns 16 yrs in 2012 (or is older) competes in the Senior Division.

An athlete younger than the above guideline will compete as a Junior.
